


## Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London. Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will depart at 0636 and run later than normal throughout. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, some trains between London Paddington and Swindon / South Wales will be retimed, in many cases, departing EARLIER than usual. Sunday - All day, some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Some trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare will either not run or will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Monday to Thursday - The 2228 (Monday to Wednesday) & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run from Swindon to Bristol Temple Meads, serving Chippenham and Bath Spa. The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway, extending journey times. Most westbound trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading and 5 Swindon. Eastbound trains will arrive later at Swindon, Reading and London Paddington. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers should check their journeys before travelling. (8) Tuesday to Friday - The 0532 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. Monday to Thursday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, with a connecting rail service from Guildford to Reading. **29** Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford and will terminate at Redhill. The 0559 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Stroud and Gloucester. A few late evening buses will be extended to run to/from Cheltenham Spa, otherwise rail connections will be available between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. Most trains between Swindon and Stroud will be retimed. A few trains will not run at all. Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.

Sunday - The 0938 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Shrub Hill will start from Bristol Parkway and will be diverted to run non-stop to

Gloucester. The 2157 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted to run non-stop from Gloucester to Bristol Parkway

- Monday The 0501 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury. A connecting train will run from Westbury to Portsmouth Harbour.
- **Tuesday to Thursday** The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. A few early morning / late evening buses will run from / to Bristol Temple Meads.
- Monday to Wednesday The 2054 Exmouth to Barnstaple will terminate at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run instead. Yeoford will be served by a separate minibus shuttle to / from Crediton only.

## The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

- Tuesday to Thursday 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
  - **Friday** 0045 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday** 0649 Ealing Broadway to Reading, 0636 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
- **Friday** The 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
